We are small, owned and operated by two women with a passion for wine - Winemaker Deb Schatzlein’s philosophy is to take the highest quality grapes and allow them to express their full potential by applying low-impact, hands-on winemaking techniques. Her technique is grounded in the science of winemaking and enlightened by over a decade of hands-on experience and intuition. Winegrower Cindy Paulson’s farming philosophy is deeply rooted in sustainable practices, coming from her background as a farmer’s daughter and environmental engineer and her love of the outdoors.

Hawks Butte Vineyard started as a raw piece of rocky hillside at the top of the fog layer, heated by southern exposure during the day and cooled by coastal breezes at night. We planted the vineyard in Syrah and Merlot in 1999 and 2000, and released our first wines in 2002.

At Bink Wines, we are all about making wines that people enjoy. Our winery will always be small, sized so that the two of us can maintain “hands on” every aspect of grape growing, winemaking, marketing, and so that we can stay close to our customers.
